PERFORMING ACTIVITIES

Concert Series

The SBMC presents the largest concert series in the Santa Barbara area: twice-monthly concerts from October to June. MATINÉE CONCERTS are held at 3 p.m. various Saturdays at Faulkner Gallery of the Santa Barbara Public Library and other venues, and feature Performer Members and invited guests.

Two Scholarship Winners Concerts are held at the conclusion of the season, presenting winners of the SBMC Scholarship Awards. In addition, gala concerts commemorating composer anniversaries or other special events are often scheduled.

Concerts highlight both traditional and contemporary repertoire, performed by instrumental and vocal soloists and chamber ensembles.

All concerts are open to the public, admission is free, and venues are wheelchair accessible.

Concert information is available on the SBMC website, in our monthly newsletters, in local newspapers and on radio.

Community Outreach

SBMC members regularly present solo and chamber music performances at retirement homes and care centers. These programs are an important extension of our commitment to bring music into the community, especially to shut-ins who are unable to attend our regular concerts.

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

Scholarships

Through the generosity of our donors, the SBMC awards scholarships to talented young performers who are residents of Santa Barbara County. Announcement of these annual scholarships is made in late January, and Guidelines and Application Forms are posted on the SBMC website.

PUBLICATIONS

Newsletter

This monthly publication is sent to all members, and contains programs of upcoming SBMC concerts, notices of other local musical events, and articles of interest to members. The Newsletter is sent as hard copy, but members may elect to receive it via email instead.

Yearbook

The SBMC publishes an Annual Yearbook, sent to all members. The yearbook includes the following listings: concerts dates/venues for the current season, Board of Directors, committee chairs and members, donors, scholarship awardees, performing and teaching members, and a Membership Directory.

GOVERNANCE

Board of Directors

The SBMC is governed by a Board of Directors, including elected officers, committee chairs, and other members. The Board meets monthly during the concert season.

Committees

Committees, which carry out the SBMC's activities, include: Community Outreach, Concert, Concert Support, Development, Hospitality, Membership, Newsletter, Nominating, Publicity, Scholarship, Workshops and Yearbook.

Meetings

An annual business meeting, open to all members, is held at the beginning of the last Morning Concert of each season.
